

WATER FIELD TRIPS AT HAVENWOODS STATE FOREST

SPLASH!

Create a model of a watershed, follow the water to the lowest spot at Havenwoods, dip in the pond to find aquatic indicator species, and travel back in time to imagine how water quality in Milwaukee has changed.
Up to 60 students.



WET + WILD

Dip in the pond to search for aquatic invertebrates, explore the area around the pond for clues to aquatic food webs, observe the amazing adaptations of pond critters, and consider how people have mimicked animals in solving design problems.
Up to 30 students.
