MMSD has limited funds available to pay for buses. Ask for details.

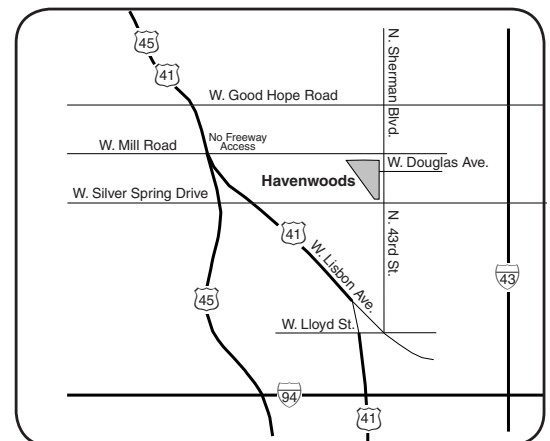
